

Cookies policy

At DirectEndodontics, we strongly believe in transparency as regards the collection and use of data. We would thus like to inform you about our cookies policy, explaining how and when we use them.

What is a cookie?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer or mobile device when you browse the DirectEndodontics website (the "Website"). These files contain information about your preferences and activities on the Website, as well as the interactions that you have had with it.

Cookies may be used for varied purposes, such as improving your experience by allowing the Website to remember your preferences, monitoring your activity on the Website, or even allowing advertisers to display targeted ads based on your interests. However, the cookies used on the DirectEndodontics website are not used for advertising purposes.

Does DirectEndodontics use cookies?

How does DirectEndodontics use cookies?

Which third-party cookies does DirectEndodontics use?

The third-party cookies used by DirectEndodontics come from Youtube.com. Third-party cookies are limited to the Website and are not operated by the DirectEndodontics services.

What can you do if you do not want cookies to be created, if you want to delete them or if you want to disable interest-based targeting?

Some people prefer to not allow cookies, which is why most browsers allow you to manage them according to your preferences. Some browsers allow you to define rules to manage cookies on a site-by-site basis, giving you more precise control over your privacy. This means that you can refuse cookies from all sites except those you approve. You can also change your cookie preferences and settings at any time by clicking on the "Let me choose" link.

However, if you restrict the Website's ability to create cookies, it could affect your overall user experience and/or prevent you from accessing personalised services. It may also prevent you from saving personalised settings, such as your login information.
